James Aynsley was born in 1801, in Longton, Staffordshire, England, United Kingdom. He married Charlotte Anderson on 25 June 1821, in Trentham, Staffordshire, England, United Kingdom. They were the parents of at least 3 sons and 3 daughters. He lived in Stoke upon Trent, Staffordshire, England, United Kingdom in 1841. He died in September 1841, in Longton, Staffordshire, England, United Kingdom, at the age of 40, and was buried in Longton, Staffordshire, England, United Kingdom.

He died on 7 February 1907, in Longton, Staffordshire, England, United Kingdom, at the age of 84.
